1. Overview of the society

2. Academic Year Highlights

The academic Year 2019 – 2020 has been a year of growth and development for all the institutions. We have made significant strides in providing high-quality education, enhancing infrastructure, and expanding our curriculum offerings.

a. +2 Shafi Muslim High School, Darbhanga.

- This is a govt. aided institution established in 1932 and declared minority character by the govt. of Bihar in 1966.
- The institution runs both secondary and senior secondary section.
- The School Continued to provide a strong foundation in the subjects offered under the Bihar Board Curriculum.
- The results of the 10th and 12th Board exams were commendable, with several students securing top ranks.
- Enhanced co-curricular activities were conducted, focusing on personality development, leadership skills, and creativity.
- Special emphasis was placed on ensuring that students received a holistic education that integrates modern pedagogical technique.

During this financial year the trust left no stone unturned to improve the academic as well as extra curricular activities of the enrolled and found better achievement with the help of teaching faculty. We organized sports activities and other competitive activities and the students who stood first were given medal and certificate on the auspicious occasion of the Republic Day on 26th January 2020 and also released “Shafi Mojalla” a souvenir in which the articles of students and teachers were published.

b. Dr. Z. H. T. T. College, Laheriasarai, Darbhanga

- The College continued to provide a teacher education programme two years B.Ed., M.Ed. Course which is permanently affiliated by L.N.M.U. Darbhanga, and permanently recognized by Govt. of Bihar and N.C.T.E., New Delhi. It also runs two years D.El.Ed. Course affiliated by B.S.E.B., Patna and recognized N.C.T.E., New Delhi.
- A National Seminar organized by the college on the Topic of “Challenges of value based education in Global Context” held on 19-20 October 2019.
- An Orientation Programme organized by the College on 28.10.2019.
- 10th National Voters Day held on 25.01.2020.
- Special emphasis is placed on ensuring that students reviewed a holistic education that integrates pedagogical Technique.
- The College remain closed because of Lock down for covid- 19 from 20th March 2020 onward.

- The college's infrastructure was further developed with the addition of modern laboratories library resources, and technology-enhanced classrooms.

The matter was resolved positively to open and run to provide facilities to minorities. In several schemes including health, education was taken up among the minorities' classes or people and we helped to avail of government aids etc. in this direction.

RURAL & SANITATION DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Society organized many programmes for rural development and working for upliftment of the life and livelihood of rural India. aims to promote a single window delivery need based services in the area of education, health, nutrition, weather, environment, agriculture and livelihoods to rural women and men.

SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

Our society organizes vocational training programme for women welfare, child and youths belonging to the informal economy. It is not just an organization but also a confluence of training programme to encourage self-resident and self-employment.

CULTURAL AWARENESS PROGRAMME:
