1. Key Points

a. +2 Shafi Muslim High School, Darbhanga.

- This is a govt. aided institution established in 1932 and declared minority character by the govt. of Bihar in 1966.
- The institution runs both secondary and senior secondary section.
- The School Continued to provide a strong foundation in the subjects offered under the Bihar Board Curriculum.
- The results of the 10th and 12th Board exams were commendable, with several students securing top ranks.
- Enhanced co-curricular activities were conducted, focusing on personality development, leadership skills, and creativity.
- Special emphasis was placed on ensuring that students should receive a better education with modern pedagogical techniques.

In the given financial year the institution running under trust tried its best to improve the academic as well as extra curricular activities of the students enrolled. and found better achievement with the help of teaching faculty. The school organized sports activities and other competitive activities and the students who ranked top were given medal and certificate on the auspicious occasion of the Republic Day on 26th January 2022 and also released “Shafi Mojalla” a souvenir in which the articles of students and teachers were published.

b. Dr. Z. H. T. T. College, Laheriasarai, Darbhanga

- The College continued to provide a teacher education programme of two years B.Ed., M.Ed. Course which is permanently affiliated by L.N.M.U. Darbhanga, permanently recognize by Govt. of Bihar and N.C.T.E., New Delhi and two years D.El.Ed. Course affiliated by B.S.E.B., Patna and recognized by N.C.T.E., New Delhi.
- The Classes has been organized through Online because of the 2nd phase of Covid-19.
- The College distributed blankets to the poor people of the District/Town because of the suffering Severe cold wave on 06.01.2022
- The College organized voter awareness campaign on 10.01.2021.
- The College organized an orientation programme form 02.03.2021 to 06.03.2021.
- On dt. 10.05.2021 College organized a seminar on the topic "**Value Education, Need of Time**".
- In 2021-2022, the college organized a National Seminar with the collaboration of IATE held on 01 August to 03rd August 2021 on the topic "**Challenges of New Education Policy 2020**".
- On the occasion of Human Rights Day the college celebrates it with one day lecture on 10th December 2021.

- Affiliated to DGET New Delhi in 2002, New Delhi.
- From 2021 – 2022 students passed and get job in different Technical Organization.
- Students Skilled in Fitter and Electrician Trade.
- Qualified Instructor trained students.
- From 2021 – 2022 students qualified multi training and sponsored by different companies. They are working as a competent Technician.
- The infrastructure of the institute was further developed with the addition modern laboratories library resources, and technology-enhanced classrooms.
- The Institute organized convocation, plantation and gardening programs.
- More than 60% students got job placement after visiting several companies at the campus such as Maruti, Suzuki, Mahindra Etc.

The matter was resolved positively to open and run to provide facilities to minorities. In several schemes including health, education was taken up among the minorities' classes or people and we helped them avail of government aids etc. in this direction.

Society organized many programmes for rural development and worked for upliftment of the life and livelihood of rural India. aims to promote a single window delivery need based services in the area of education, health, nutrition, weather, environment, agriculture and livelihoods to rural women and men.
