1. Academic Year At a Glance:

The academic Year 2022 – 2023 shows the achievement and activities done by the institutions running under the trust. We have adopted several steps in providing high-quality education, enhancing infrastructure, and expanding our curriculum offerings as the changes made time to time.

a. +2 Shafi Muslim High School, Darbhanga.

- This is a govt. aided institution established in 1932 and declared minority character by the govt. of Bihar in 1966.
- The institution runs both secondary and senior secondary section.
- The School Continued to provide a strong foundation in the subjects offered under the Bihar Board Curriculum.
- The results of the 10th and 12th Board exams were commendable, with several students securing top ranks.
- Enhanced co-curricular activities were conducted, focusing on personality development, leadership skills, and creativity.
- The school arranges parents teacher meeting several times during the academic session.
- The school also organized extra curricular activities such as games and sports, debate and discussions, essay writing, quiz competition and so on.
- Special emphasis was placed on ensuring that students should receive a better education with modern teaching techniques.

In the given financial year the institution running under trust tried its best to improve the academic as well as extra curricular activities of the students enrolled and found better achievement with the help of teaching faculty. The school organized sports activities and other competitive activities and the students who did best were given medal and certificate on the auspicious occasion of the Republic Day on 26th January 2023 and also released “**Shafi Mojalla**” a souvenir in which the articles of students and teachers were published.

b. Dr. Z. H. T. T. College, Laheriasarai, Darbhanga

- The College continued to provide a teacher education programme of two years B.Ed., M.Ed. Course which is permanently affiliated by L.N.M.U. Darbhanga and permanently recognized by Govt. of Bihar and N.C.T.E., New Delhi and also two years D.El.Ed. Course affiliated by B.S.E.B., Patna and recognized with N.C.T.E., New Delhi.
- Dr. Z.H.T.T. College organized the National Seminar under IATE on the topic was "**New Education Policy 2020: Road Map of Teacher Education**" held on the 26th March to 28th March 2022. The Conference was attended by 500 delegates all over India. The conference was presided by Vice-Chancellor L.N.M.U. Darbhanga Dr. S. P. Singh. The Conference was most successful.
- An orientation programme was organized by the college speaker Prof. Jitendra Narayan in month of October-2022.
- Dr. Z.H.T.T. College organized "**AZADI KA MAHOTSAV HAR GHAR TIRANGA**" in August-2022.
- The College also organized the seminar on the topic was "**Future of NEP-2020 and its Challenges**" in August-2022.
- The College also organized an awareness talk for women on the topic of "Role of Mother Hygienic Issues by Dr. Pushpa Kumari, MD., Gynaecologist held on 05.12.2022.
- The College distributed blankets among the poor people of the town because of the suffering severe cold wave on 25.12.2022 in the district.
- The college organized plantation programme in the college campus.

- From 2022 – 2023 students passed and get job in different Technical Organization.
- Students Skilled in Fitter and Electrician Trade.
- Qualified Instructor trained students.
- From 2022 – 2023 students qualified multi training and sponsored by different companies. Many of them selected and serving as a better technician.
- The infrastructure was further developed and some repairing work was done.
- The Institute organized convocation, plantation and gardening programs.
- More than 65% students got job placement after visiting several companies at the campus.
