

Smelling - Olfactory senses


Tasting - Sense of taste

Touching - Tactile recognition











- Phenomenal transcend in the children's attitudes towards books, libraries, reading, and technology




TO BUILD CREATIVE, DISCIPLINED AND DYNAMIC LEADERS OF TOMORROW

Opportunities for children


- to begin to know what activities they are good at.














AWAKENING INDIANS TO INDIA
